

Union Volunteers Field Hospital Guidelines for Events

- 1) All injuries or illness should be reported to the field hospital.
- 2) All re-enactors, officers and enlisted, are required to carry a full canteen of water when going out to the field. Any re-enactor found not carrying a full canteen will be pulled from the field by the medical staff.
- 3) It is recommended that all re-enactors begin drinking water at least 1 hour before leaving for the field.
- 4) Each re-enactor should carry a medical card on them at all times during an event.

The card should include the re-enactors:

- name
- address
- phone number
- emergency contact
- allergies
- Medical conditions.

A duplicate card should be held by the company commander in charge at the event.

- 5) Any re-enactor who is certified in first aid should report to the field hospital on the first day of the event to identify themselves to the hospital staff.
- 6) When hospital staff is in attendance at an event, water and Gatorade will be available 24 hours a day at the field hospital. The hospital staff is available for any emergencies from the time they arrive until the end of the event, should you need them.
